Urinary infections, cystitis, gout, rheumatism, in prevention of kidney stones, liver disorders.

Side effects:

Allergies to birch -> do not take as a precaution.

Contra-indications:

Pregnancy, young children.

Parts used:

Dried leaves and bark.

Galenic forms:

In the form of herbal tea, juice, capsules.
